Upon receipt of meter reading data for the respective Hydro Stations from PTC, the REA for February'16 in respect of Chukha HPS and Tala HPS is hereby prepared and issued.


It is observed that for the month, Bhutan, through Kurichhu System has imported power from Indian system of the tune of approximately 13,322 MWH which is higher than the energy received through the Tala System. The same has would be adjusted subsequently from Tala HPS.
